Under 7 Mixed Tee Ball Rocks!

The new 6 a-side format for the Under 7 T-Ballers is receiving the "thumbs up" from parents and coaches.

On the first day, teams were getting through 6 bats and 6 fields well within the time limit. A fantastic effort by all involved.

Remember, the base lines are 12 meters (12 steps) for T-Ballers, so take care to set the Diamond out correctly, to ensure the children can realistically make those throws.

Let's get the colour sequence of the cones right too:
First – yellow, Second – Green, Right Field – Orange, Left Field – White, Short Stop – Blue and Third – Orange.

Especially to begin with, the children need consistency with this, to help them remember the fielding sequence. Let us know about ways that work for you to get the players to remember where they have to go to the next fielding inning – we really want them to know where they are going next without having to be told, before too long.
